The Karl Mayer Foundation is a private institution, which within the designated contex of charitable and public benefit purposes effects donations, that serves the individual as well as the general public.

The ten years of its existence is cause for the Karl Mayer Foundation to honour their founder in a publication and to inform the public, among whom they work, of its intentions and actions.

Karl Mayer (1900 - 1981), a businessman from Basel, lived in the Principality of Liechtenstein since 1951. In accordance with his longterm wish he established a Foundation here, which is to maintain his fortune, made with great personal involvement and great stamina, far beyond his death and to apply it for the most varied types of support and grants.

The purpose of the Karl Mayer Foundation is to manage, secure and, as far as possible, increase the assets of the Foundation and to give grants exclusively for charitable and non-profit making activities. Karl Mayer conceived this wide specific purpose so that his Foundation can undertake an appropriate contribution to
